

**Town Steering Committee for “*Complete Streets and Active Transportation*”:  
Bicycling, Pedestrians & Trails.** The purpose and guidelines for the committee are:

- ◆ Educate and Advocate for “*Complete Streets and Active Transportation*”
- ◆ Advise Town Board regarding *Complete Streets* policy and goals;
- ◆ Act as a collaborator to create strong, multidisciplinary partnerships with local agencies and organizations to advance *Complete Streets* and Trails in ways that improve our health, economy and environment;
- ◆ Inventory existing pedestrian and bicycling transportation infrastructure of local, county and state highways within Town of Plattsburgh;
- ◆ Make recommendations, with priorities, for safer “active transport” in Town of Plattsburgh;
- ◆ Make recommendation to Town Board as the initial Town organizing vehicle for Saranac River Trail Greenway (SRGT) and trail connectors to the SRGT;
- ◆ Provide recommendation to Town Board for “future” committee organization after an initial 18 to 24 month period of the Steering Committee.

**Note: Active Transport is defined as human powered modes of transportation such as walking and biking.**
